- \* There are some large bullant nests around, one in the big sky camp which has danger tape around it. Don't disturb them or walk on or around the nests as this gets them angry and bitey.
- \* A mob of Kangaroos are usually on the proper-
- \* Rabbits & foxes are around
- \* The property is home to southern brown tree frogs which you might see hopping about
- x if you are lucky, you might spot a lace monitor or tree goanna
- \* USE SUNSCREEN, KEEP A FIRST AID KIT, BE SAFE
